What makes quality embroidery?

There are many variables that can impact the quality of embroidery making it nearly impossible to get a perfect job every time. And, since embroidery is a form of art, many times quality embroidery is "in the eye of the beholder"! However, there are certain parameters that do constitute Quality Embroidery. In this workshop we review the five steps in a typical embroidery process and the important parameters that should considered.

- Five steps in a typical embroidery process from concept to finishing and inspection.
- Common embroidery stitches, showing where and when they are typically used.
- The importance of proper digitizing and its impact on the final embroidery quality.
- Selecting the proper trim items (backing, topping, thread).
- Measuring for proper embroidery placement.
- Common embroidery problems and solutions
