Knit Applications

Knit Fabric: A fabric structure produced by inter-looping one or more ends of yarn together. The two major classes of knitting are warp knitting and weft knitting. There are many knit patterns but the most common constructions include the jersey, ribbed, and tricot.

The threads below are the most common thread types and sizes used by manufacturers around the world.

- #1 Selection should be used where there are special requirements, such as a) minimizing thread breakage & seam failures; b) for sewing special fabrics that are susceptible to excessive needle holes; and c) where quality seaming is a must.
- #2 Selection should be used where sewing requirements are not as difficult and cost is the major consideration.

The following recommendations include the most common thread type & size used for a particular sewn product. In many cases, other thread types are sometimes used from buttonsewing, buttonholing, blindstitching, and other special requirements like overdyeing, etc.

TEX SIZE: Is the gram weight of 1000M of greige yarn. The larger the Tex Size, the heavier the Thread Size.
